# Learn to speak pog with PPSA...

Since dogs can't speak words, their body will say if they're frightened or worried or happy to play.



These dogs are all showing signs of not being happy and are telling you to leave them alone...

Half-moon eyes





Eyes bulging and fixed stare. Showing teeth. Ears back

Licking lips and mouth closed



Cowering with head down and ears back



#### If you see any of the above signs, walk away from the dog

- Dogs prefer to be stroked gently rather than being held or kissed and cuddled
- NEVER touch a sick or injured dog, even if you know it really well
- ALWAYS ask the owner before approaching a dog you don't know
- NEVER take food or toys from dogs or wake them when they're sleeping.
